4. Requests that support participants over 18 years old (Bohemian Foundation identifies "youth" from birth through grade 12, or through age 18 if not enrolled in secondary education)
5. Music related requests (See Bohemian Foundation's Music Programs goals for Music Program eligibility)

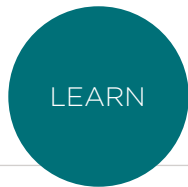
