	VETERANS SERVICES
8	Catholic Charities: information about the homeless shelter, Veterans Program, and scheduling appointments for Veteran Rent Assistance.
9	Cheyenne VA Medical Center: information regarding enrollment, housing assistance, and accessing mental health, medical, employment, and other VA services.
17	Healing Warriors Program: information on Veteran services, including healing touch, acupuncture, and craniosacral therapy.
16	Rocky Mountain Human Services - Homes for All Veterans Program: information and enrollment assistance, preventing homelessness, or rapidly re-house homeless.
Outside Courts	The Salvation Army: information on services, as well as hygiene kits, sack lunches, and coffee.
10	Volunteers of America: screenings for homeless and near homeless Veterans to access assistance with housing.
	HOUSING RESOURCES
18	Faith Family Hospitality: information for families looking for short-term shelter while job searching and moving toward attaining permanent housing.
11	Fort Collins Housing Authority: sign-up forms for the subsidized voucher waitlists and opportunity for those already signed up to check on status.
19	Neighbor to Neighbor: information on rental housing resources.
	EMPLOYMENT SERVICES
14	Homeless Gear – Hand Up Program: help for job-seekers who are homeless or near homeless to gain and maintain self-sufficiency. Providing one-on-one career counseling and individualized mentorship.
15	Larimer County Workforce Center: information on job searching for adults, youth and veterans.
	GOVERNMENT AND LEGAL SERVICES
29	Colorado Legal Services: legal resource and referral information.
28	Colorado ID Project: vouchers for state ID cards and driver's licenses and screening for those who may need more extensive assistance.
21	Fort Collins Municipal Court: court clerks will be available to check on the status of any outstanding tickets. The municipal judge will also be available via phone to hear any cases and offer alternative penalties to fines.
20	Larimer County Human Services: information about services such as food, cash, and medical assistance to help individuals and families achieve self-sufficiency and well-being.
	YOUTH/FAMILY RESOURCES
5	Children's Books: each family may choose one book per child to take home. Donated by Book Trust.
7	The Family Center / La Familia: information about family strengthening services: early childhood education programs, youth programs, goal setting and family development, and classes, including computer, parenting, citizenship, and health.
Eagle Room 3	Free Child Care During Event: the Family Center and CSU partner together to offer families a secure child care area during the event. Fun activities for children will be provided.
12	The Matthews House: information on services provided at our Youth & Family Center, Community Life Center, and School Based Navigator pilot program.
6	PSD Early Childhood: early childhood education and support to families from prenatal to age 5 in the Fort Collins and Larimer County area.
13	Project Self-Sufficiency: information and materials about PS-S, including single parent career exploration and education, as well as any support for referrals

4	Bear Heart School of Massage: chair massages.
Outside Courts	Bike Repair Services: basic repairs and tune-ups.
1	Blue Jay Wireless: distributing cell phones and information as part of the national Lifeline program.
Outside Courts	CSU Community Veterinary Practice & Pets Forever: on-site pet sitting services along with dog and cat exams and vaccinations.
Gym 1	Cheeks International Academy of Beauty Culture: haircuts for adults and children.
25	Christ Clinic: on-site nurse to assess patients' needs to see a physician, and make an appointment for Christ Clinic's free medical clinic in Old Town Fort Collins.
33	Crossroads Safehouse: information about services and safe housing for children and adults affected by intimate partner abuse.
Outside Courts	Dellenbach Motors: basic car inspection.
22	DentaQuest: information about the Colorado Medicaid Dental Program including how to find a dental provider along with oral health education for children.
31	Disabled Resource Services: information on services related to social security disability and case management.
Eagle Rooms 1-2	Eye Center of Northern Colorado: vision screenings and eye glasses with comparable prescriptions. Vouchers to Lens Crafters for a free pair of eye glasses if a matching prescription is not available.
23	Food Bank for Larimer County: information for the Food Share Program (direct service fresh food pantry) and youth programs including Kids Café, Backpacks, and Kids Link.
30	Fort Collins Rescue Mission: information about Steps to Success (S2S) plans addressing homeless issues of unemployment, money management, addictions, relationship issues, etc.
Outside Courts	Health District of Northern Larimer County - Adult Dental Van: adult dental screenings and referrals.
24	Homeless Gear - Dedicated Navigators Program: helping individuals and families who are homeless or low-income complete forms and apply for benefits (Food Assistance, Medicaid, TANF, etc.) for which they may be eligible.
Gym 3	Homeless Gear – Gear Distribution Program: supplies that help individuals and families survive in the short-term.
34	Larimer Health Connect: family assistance in applying for Medicaid, CHP+ and the Connect for Health Colorado Marketplace.
27	Northern Colorado AIDS Project: HIV/HCV rapid antibody testing, information about HIV/HCV care and prevention, as well as free safer sex supplies.
2	Poudre River Public Library: distributing books for adults.
Outside Courts	Prevent Unwanted Pets (PUP): providing pet food and information about pet spay/neuter assistance.
Outside Courts	Saint Joseph Mobile Mammography Van: providing annual routine mammograms.
Outside Courts	Salud Family Health Center: mobile medical unit for free health screenings.
Gym 1	Sandberg Photography: family and individual portraits.
26	The Sexual Assault Victim Advocate Center: providing referrals to our counseling program; individual advocacy and in-person support.
3	Soaring Wings Ministries: providing items such as socks (for all ages) and goodie bags with school supplies for children.
35	SummitStone Health Partners: information about mental health and substance abuse services provided by the PATH program located at the Murphy Center.
