







FORT COLLINS ARTS MARKET STUDY FACT SHEET

The Fort Collins Arts Market Study is a study designed to assess the needs of the arts, cultural and creative communities for affordable housing and workspace for individual artists/creatives and arts/cultural organizations and businesses. Artspace, a nonprofit real estate developer, is conducting the study. The City of Fort Collins, Fort Collins Downtown Development Authority and Bohemian Foundation are the three partners that invited Artspace to Fort Collins to explore the potential of developing affordable spaces where creatives of all disciplines may live and work and arts/cultural organizations and businesses can thrive.

- The Arts Market Study will provide an in-depth analysis of the space needs of area creatives.
- Survey data may help attract funders, encourage the creation of space by private developers and advance a possible project.
- The Arts Market Study consists of two surveys: an individual artist survey and a survey for leaders of arts and cultural organizations and creative or arts-friendly businesses.
- The surveys are available online at <u>focoartspace.org</u>.
- The surveys close June 19, 2017.
- All creatives in the Fort Collins community and surrounding areas are encouraged to respond to the survey.
- Artspace will provide the survey results within six months after the close of the surveys.

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
