What: <u>Bohemian Foundation</u> is pleased to announce that the Pharos Fund is now accepting applications for the Spring 2016 grant round. The Pharos Fund is a responsive grant making initiative of Bohemian Foundation's Community Programs. Community Programs goals were recently updated and expanded, so organizations that may not have been previously eligible are encouraged to review the fund's updated guidelines.

Who: Pharos Fund is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications from both 501(c)(3) organizations and eligible governmental units serving a charitable purpose.

Applicants must provide services within the Poudre School District boundary. Applicants do not need to be headquartered in Fort Collins to receive funding. However, applicants must serve clients within the Poudre School District boundary or have a direct impact on individuals in our grantmaking area.

When: Bohemian Foundation will accept applications until 11:59 p.m. on Feb. 4.
